## MARCH 1, 2021

The Board of County Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m., March 1, 2021 in a regular meeting. The advance public notice of the meeting was posted at 3:32 p.m., February 25, 2021 in prominent view in the office of the County Clerk, the office of the County Commissioners, the first-floor bulletin board in the Garfield County Courthouse, and the outside Bulletin Board, Enid, Oklahoma.
