The advance public notice of the meeting was posted at 3:59 p.m., April 25, 2024 in prominent view in the office of the County Clerk, the office of the County Commissioners, the first-floor bulletin board in the Garfield County Courthouse, and the outside Bulletin Board, Enid, Oklahoma.
